Read Psalm 119:105

DAY
1

Get to Know Someone Better

Think of some things you would like to know about one of your friends or family members. It could be their favorite color, favorite food or even dream pet. Spend some time asking that person your questions and draw a picture showing what you now know about them.

DAY
2

Learn Something About Jesus

Just like the wise men studied to learn about Jesus, you can too! Have someone read Matthew 19:13-15 to you. Talk about what this story tells you about Jesus. Then, thank God for the Bible so you can learn about Him.

DAY
3

Make a Map

The wise men followed a star that led them to Jesus. Place your Bible in one part of the house, then make a map of how to find your Bible. Give your map to an older family member. When they find your Bible, read Matthew 2 together.

4

"Work Out" the Verses

With a parent, repeat the Bible verse for this week while doing your favorite exercises like jumping jacks, squats, or push-ups. Ask God to help you remember His Word so you can know Jesus better.

BOTTOM LINE: What God says is the most important thing to know.

Read Proverbs 2:6

DAY

1

Then & Now

Jesus went to the temple to worship and learn about God. Two thousand years later, we go to church for pretty much the same reason. Draw a picture of your favorite thing that happens at church.

DAY

2

Family Theatre

As a family read Luke 2:41-52. Assign parts to different members of the family and act out the story. Family members can play multiple parts if they like. Then, pray together to thank God that you can learn about Jesus from the Bible.

DAY

4

Bible Verse Beanbag

Have your parents write out Proverbs 2:6— one word per slip of paper. Then compete to see who can toss a beanbag on the words in the correct order. If you don't have a beanbag use rice in a baggie, a kitchen sponge, or a pair of socks tied together. Read the verse with your family and remind each other that wisdom comes from God.

DAY

3

Ask for It

Our Bible verse reminds us that wisdom comes from God. Ask God to help you make wise choices every day this week with this prayer, "God, please help me to make wise choices with my family, my friends, and everything I do this week. I love You, God! Amen."

Read Psalm 119:66

DAY

1

Follow the Leader

Play "Follow the Leader" with a friend or family member. Make sure you get at least one turn following! How did you know what to do to follow? By watching and listening to the leader, right? You can do the same with Jesus by reading your Bible and doing what it says.

DAY

2

Steps To Follow Jesus

Jesus says we are to love God and others. Name three ways you can show love to God and three ways you can show love to others this week. Make a checklist and put it somewhere you look every day.

DAY

3

Who do you Follow?

Who are the people in your life that you are supposed to follow? Your parents? Teachers? Community leaders? Ask your parents why it's important to follow these people. Then have them read Proverbs 1:7 and answer the question, "Why is it important to follow Jesus?"

4

Good Sense Prayer

This week, pray and ask God to help you love Him and other people. Pray specifically for friends and family by including their names in this prayer, "God, help me to love You and to love _____ and _____. Help me to have good sense and to trust Your commands. Thank You for loving me! Amen."

BOTTOM LINE: Discovering what God says helps you make the wise choice.

Read Proverbs 3:5

DAY
1

Guide Me

Ask someone to hide something in the house. Then try and find it without any help. After you have tried hard enough, ask that person to “guide” you by telling you when you are close to the hidden object and when you are far away. How much easier was it to rely on the other person rather than guessing yourself?

DAY
2

What Tempts You?

Sometimes we are tempted (we want) to do something or take something we should not. Draw a picture of a time you were tempted to do something you were told not to do. Look at that picture this week and remember that knowing God’s Word will help you resist temptation.

3


Prescription for Temptation

When Satan tempted Jesus, Jesus used scripture and prayer to resist. This week, challenge yourself to memorize Proverbs 3:5 and pray this prayer, “God, help me to learn Your Word like Jesus did so that I can make wise choices like Jesus did. Thank You, I love You, God! Amen.”

4

Memory Verse Hopscotch

Have a parent write the memory verse down, making sure there is only one word per piece of paper. Now arrange the paper in a hopscotch pattern on the floor. Using a rock, play hopscotch, sounding out the words as you land on them. Ask someone to help you get all the words right.

Read James 1:5

DAY

1

Ask Away

Sit down with a parent or friend and spend some time asking questions. Let them ask you some questions as well. Draw a picture of one of the answers you thought was most interesting. Look at the picture and think about how much you can learn when you ask!

DAY

2

What Do I Ask?

Think of five questions you would like to know the answer to. They can be questions for parents, friends, teachers, or for God. Now, ask all of the questions you thought of and any other that come up. Were some questions harder to ask than others? Know that you can ask God anything!

DAY

3

Don't Ask

For one day, try not to ask for or about anything. Do you learn much? What were some of the questions you stopped yourself from asking? It is very hard to learn new things if you do not ask questions.

DAY

4

Pray for Wisdom

We often pray for physical things like toys. This week, use this prayer to ask God to give you wisdom, "Dear God, please help me to be wise. Thank you for wisdom and for teaching us through Your Word. I love You, God! Amen."
